- 6. Selection Procedure. Shortlisting of candidates (meeting all criteria as mentioned at Para 2 above and received as on the closing date of advertisement) for written examination will be made tradewise as per extant policies for the number of vacancies indicated at Para 1. The following process will be followed in respect of selection and corresponding merits for Written examination, Document verification and Final Joining Letter:-
